Alternative Energy Waste Acceptance Policy

GENERAL POLICY

The purpose of the Alternative Energy Waste Acceptance Policy for the Benton County Solid Waste Disposal Commission (BCSWDC) is to identify expectations, and procedures for the management of any alternative energy waste; including, but not limited to, wind turbines, windmill blades and solar panels.

This policy is intended to ensure that proper monitoring and regulatory procedures are in place to adequately manage alternative energy waste generated in Benton County.

SPECIFIC PROVISIONS

BCSWDC full-time employees will be expected to implement the identified Alternative Energy Waste Acceptance Policy management best practices.

Any alternative energy waste accepted at the landfill must be generated in Benton County only and the specific site must be referenced.

The alternative energy waste shall be directly hauled to our Landfill.

The landfill shall be notified at least twenty four (24) hours in advance of the intended delivery.

Wind Turbines and Windmill Blades shall be cut lengthwise into no greater than twenty foot (20) lengths and then, those pieces shall also be cut in half horizontally.

Any alternative energy waste shall be accepted in roll off containers no greater than a forty yard (40 CY) dumpster with a self-dumping mechanism.

Carbon fiber resins of any type are prohibited.

ENFORCEMENT

Operations Manager has the responsibility to enforce this policy.

DISPOSAL FEES

Wind Turbines and Windmill Blades:	\$2,000.00 per/ton
Solar Panels:	\$2000.00 per/ton
The Disposal Fee for any alternative energy waste is:	\$1.00 per pound / \$50.00 minimum

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
