OUT OF SERVICE AREA WASTE POLICY

GENERAL POLICY

To discourage waste coming from outside our service area, the Benton County Solid Waste Disposal Commission maintains an Out Of Service Area Waste Disposal Policy.

SPECIFIC PROVISIONS

The Benton County Solid Waste Disposal Commission defines the Benton County Landfill Service Area as the boundaries of Benton County, Iowa.

The Benton County Landfill accepts only solid waste from residents and businesses located in Benton County, Iowa.

All self-haulers bringing waste from outside the Service Area will be turned away and redirected to the waste facility serving the county where the waste was generated. Self-haulers that misrepresent the origin of their load will be assessed double the current tip fee when identified and banned from using the Benton County Landfill in the future.

Permitted haulers who receive the reduced tip fee for waste transported to the Benton County Landfill and that violate this policy will receive a verbal warning for the first occurrence and the second occurrence will revoke their reduced tip fee. They will be charged the standard tip fee of \$60 per ton.

Out of Service Area Disposal Requests for waste generated in the ECICOG planning area are exempt from this policy and are handled on a case by case basis.

ENFORCEMENT

Operations Manager and Landfill Staff have the responsibility to enforce this policy.
